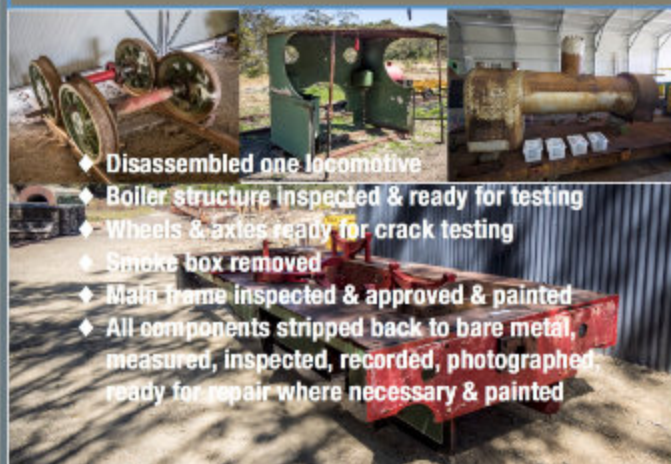

What we have done



- ◆ Disassembled one locomotive
- ◆ Boiler structure inspected & ready for testing
- ◆ Wheels & axles ready for crack testing
- ◆ Smoke box removed
- ◆ Main frame inspected & approved & painted
- ◆ All components stripped back to bare metal, measured, inspected, recorded, photographed ready for repair where necessary & painted

What we have to do



- ◆ Build new water tank
- ◆ Build and fit new smoke box
- ◆ Purchase and fit new floor plates
- ◆ Source steam driven air compressor
- ◆ Refurbish draw gear
- ◆ Purchase paint and apply to all parts
- ◆ Re-assemble to running order
- ◆ Exhaustive testing before commercial operation
- ◆ Start work on the second locomotive
- ◆ Fit compressor and brake system

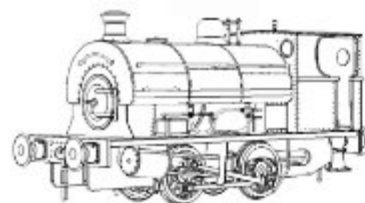

Peckett Locomotives

These interesting industrial steam locomotives were originally purchased for use at the Mt Morgan gold mine. Locomotive 1069 was purchased in 1905 & became Mt. Morgan No.4. It later became Mt Isa Mines Co Ltd No.1, where it was out of use by 1955. Peckett 1069 was initially preserved at St Joseph's Convent School, Mount Isa.

Around 1982 it was sold to a private collector and transported to Spotswood, Melbourne. In 1989 it was relocated to suburban Bayswater, Melbourne. In August 2009, both Peckett 1069 / Mt Morgan Mines No.4 and Peckett 1174 / Mt Morgan Mines No.5 became available for sale. They were sold to a collector and moved to a private location in South-East Queensland.

The two locomotives have now been acquired by the **Atherton - Herberton Historic Railway Inc**, with Peckett 1069 delivered to their Herberton base on 18 May 2015.
